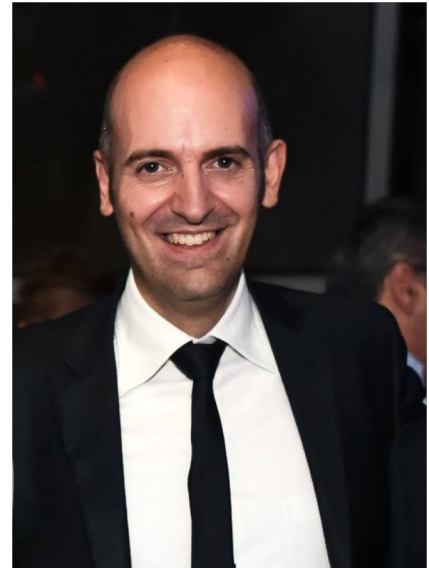


MARCO SARTOR

Short bio



Marco Sartor is Professor of Quality Management and Deputy Rector at the University of Udine, Italy.

Dr. Sartor has been the President of the European Decision Science Institute (EDSI) (2018-2019), the President of ALLig (i.e., a no-profit professional association collecting hundreds management engineers) (2004-now), the shareholder of Innov@ctors (i.e., a spin-off of the University of Udine) (2015-now).

His research interests are related to international sourcing and manufacturing, quality management, reshoring. On these topics he has published more than 40 scientific works.

He is the author of four books (by Palgrave Macmillan and IISole24ORE) and the editor of 3 books (by Gower and Emerald).

His papers (25+ refereed journal publications) were published in a variety of leading academic journals, including: *International Journal of Production Economics* (4 paper), *Journal of Purchasing and Supply Management* (4 papers), *Production Planning and Control* (4 papers), *International Journal of Operations and Production Management* (3 papers).

Dr. Sartor developed a registered patent. He received also some important research awards, such as the Chriss Voss Best Paper Award – Euroma 2017.

When Former Italian Prime Minister Romano Prodi visited India in February 2007, Dr. Sartor was included in the government delegation, aimed at supporting about 450 businessmen involved in more than 4,200 business meetings.

Marco was the Chair of the EDSI Conference in Udine and Venice (Italy). He was the track chair, PhD workshop coordinator and member of the scientific committee of other EDSI conferences. He has been Member of the EDSI Executive Board since 2015
