
Sonja Kuri finished her studies in German Studies and French Studies at the Klagenfurt University. After having concluded her studies successfully in 1987, she worked in a managerial position elaborating a 4-year correspondence University course in German Language and German didactics for Turkey within a cooperation-contract between Turkey and Austria. During a cultural agreement between Austria and Finland she spent a semester at Tampere University. In addition, she directed for three years the association “Deutsch in Österreich” at the Klagenfurt University in Austria and for eight full years she was a lecturer at the Catholic University of Milan, 4 of which as a scholarship holder from the Austrian Ministry of Education and Research for the research project “Elaboration of a learner-oriented curriculum for the study course “German, Tourism and Management (German language and literature, specializing in the touristic/managerial aspect) in a learning environment with the aid of Computer technology”.

In 1998 she terminated her Ph.D. in research with a thesis entitled “Deconstruction. Linguistic education and didactics relating to Foreign languages in Italy from 1948 to 1979 with a glance at the present day situation”.

In the year 2000 she concluded her post-graduate studies in Management in Education obtaining the qualification of “Manager of Academic Education”.

In 2002 she won the contest for L/LIN 14 – Language and Translation – German Language at the University of Udine, where she now works since December 2003 as an associate professor.

Her prime research concentrates on textlinguistics, discourse analyses and didactic topics on the teaching and learning of the German language in plurilinguistic, multicultural, multimedia conditions and their concrete application. From 2014 to 2016 she collaborated at the EU-project “On-line Reading and Writing Laboratory for Czech, German, Italian and Slovenian as L2” (www.wrilib2.eu).



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
