

Training Project Cycle XVIII

The training offer of the Doctoral Program in Law for Innovation in the European Legal Space, Cycle XXXVIII, is structured on two curricula, flanked by a common training path supporting research. In fact, a legal education of excellence, oriented to the insertion of doctoral students both in the world of scientific research and in the practical-professional world, cannot be based only on highly specific and sectorial learning, but must also aim to transmit to the learners an apparatus of critical analysis of the legal problems that characterize the current context.

THE DOCTORAL STUDENTS TRAINING PROJECT CONSIST OF

a) in the development, under the guidance of the Supervisor, of an individual research program referring to a specific disciplinary field among those on which the Course is focused;

b) in the attendance of doctoral level teaching activities complementary to research not less than 30 CFU. The recognition of CFUs, which can be acquired by attending teaching and other educational activities, is carried out by the Board of Teachers, which authorizes the attendance and evaluates the outcomes. The teaching activities, which can also be organized jointly among several Courses, also include training activities aimed at supporting research activities and providing tools to outline the professional identity of future PhDs. Specifically of:

At least 9 CFU

by attending (and passing any final examinations) four specialized courses of a general nature and in the relevant area and discipline, chosen from those scheduled annually by the Board of Teachers of the doctoral course

At least 10 CFU

with attendance (and passing of any final exams) of cross-curricular courses/seminars, chosen from those programmed annually by the Research Services Area in the areas of Mobility (compulsory English language course), Research, Digital, Communication, Career Development. At least 11 CFU

- with participation in seminars and conferences organized at the two affiliated locations, which will be promptly notified to doctoral students.
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The individual research program concludes with the writing of the thesis. The thesis, written in Italian or English, must contribute to the advancement of knowledge or methodologies in the chosen field of investigation.

The College of Teachers annually evaluates the training and research activities carried out by individual doctoral students for the purpose of admission to the following year and to the thesis evaluation stage.

The College provides for the correspondence of one credit to 7 hours of face-to-face teaching (lectures, seminars, conferences) and is required to comply within the three-year period with the commitment of at least 30 CFUs in accordance with Art. 5, Paragraph 2 (b) for activities offered at the doctoral program sites.
