- **I UDINE01** will send the letter of acceptance and information package within 8 weeks from reception of the nomination letter.

- Erasmus incoming students at **I UDINE01** have to collect the Transcript of Records before leaving Udine. Should they fail to do so, the Transcript of Records will be issued and sent directly to the students' personal address by I UDINE01 within 5 weeks.

Termination or modification of the agreement:

A unilateral decision to discontinue or to change the exchanges notified to the other party by September 20/./ will only take effect from 1st October of the following new academic year.

E CORDOBA01: After having received the paper application (printed online application) the letter of admission will be sent in a period of three weeks maximum.

E CORDOBA01: A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution as soon as possible after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.

E CORDOBA01: Termination of the agreement

A notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict"


