- Partner Universities have to send a detailed Erasmus nomination list by e-mail (to iss@uniud.it). I UDINEO1 cannot guarantee the acceptance of any other nomination modality by partner Universities (such as online nominations etc...).
- I UDINEO1 will send the letter of acceptance and information package within 8 weeks from reception of the nomination letter.

- Erasmus incoming students at **I UDINEO1** have to collect the Transcript of Records before leaving Udine. Should they fail to do so, the Transcript of Records will be issued and sent directly to the students' personal address by I UDINEO1 within 5 weeks.

Termination or modification of the agreement:

A unilateral decision to discontinue or to change the exchanges notified to the other party by September 20/../ will only take effect from 1st October of the following new academic year.

#### E CORDOBA01:

- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 6weeks.
- 3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. [It should normally not exceed five weeks according to the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education guidelines]
- 4. Termination of the agreement

[It is up to the involved institutions to agree on the procedure for modifying or terminating the inter-institutional agreement. However, in the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."]
