- 3. Partner Universities have to send a detailed Erasmus nomination list by e-mail (to iss@uniud.it). It cannot be guaranteed the acceptance of another modality to nominate Erasmus students by partner Universities (such as online nominations etc.).
- 4. I UDINEO1 will send its decision (information package) within 8 weeks at the maximum from the reception of the nomination letter.
- 5. Erasmus incoming student at the I UDINEO1 has to collect the Transcript of Records before leaving Udine, otherwise the Transcript of Records will be issued and sent by I UDINEO1 no later than 5 weeks directly to the personal post address of the student.
- 6. Termination or modification of the agreement:

A unilateral decision to discontinue or to change the exchanges notified to the other party by September 20/../ will only take effect from the October of the following new academic year.
