
5.2 Each University shall require sight of all proof materials prior to publication.

6. Dispute Resolution

The Parties agree that any dispute between them as to the intent or meaning of this agreement or the rights or obligations of any party shall if unable to be resolved by senior officers of both institutions be referred in the first instance to a private and independent mediation by a mutually acceptable suitably qualified mediator who shall assist the parties to reach an agreed resolution of the issue but who shall not be empowered to impose any resolution.
