The original transcript of records (no carbon copy is accepted) with the exams done by the Italian student can be given or sent directly to him/her OR to the International Relations and Mobility Office of I UDINE01.

The Learning Agreement or the changed Learning Agreement has to be given to the Italian student who will submit to the approval of the professor coordinator.

D REGENSB01:

- ➤ The University of Regensburg offers a **pre-semester intensive German language course** in both September and March (120 hrs of instruction; course fee: 320.-€ in 2018) which is recommended for students who have below B2 knowledge of German.
- The University of Regensburg provides a large scale orientation programme prior to the start of the semester which students are asked to take part in. It begins about one to two weeks before classes start and offers a general orientation, an overview of Germany, information about studying at UR (registration, choice of courses, learning agreement), information on administrative issues, and information on health insurance and health and safety. Students will also be shown around the campus and the city of Regensburg.

Partner Universities have to send a detailed Erasmus nomination list by e-mail (to iss@uniud.it). It cannot be guaranteed the acceptance of another modality to nominate Erasmus students by partner Universities (such as online nominations etc.).

I UDINE01 will send its decision (information package) within 8 weeks at the maximum from the reception of the nomination letter.

Erasmus incoming student at the I UDINE01 has to collect the Transcript of Records before leaving Udine, otherwise the Transcript of Records will be issued and sent by I UDINE01 no later than 5 weeks after completion of exams directly to the personal post address of the student.

DREGENSB01:

- Official letters of acceptance will be sent out to the students within 6 weeks after the deadline for application.
- > A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.

Termination or modification of the agreement:

A unilateral decision to discontinue or to change the exchanges must be notified to the other party by September 20XX will only take effect from October of the following new academic year. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.
