- Selection process: the partner university is kindly requested to ensure that the language proficiency of the outgoing student(s) is a minimum B2.

- Services for Incoming students:
 - Orientation Day is organized for international students each semester where students get information about the university in general, administrative issues, student activities, the Hungarian language course, and other services. The integration of incoming students is fostered also in the areas of education and social life.
 - The ESN mentor system ensures the acculturation of foreign students by organizing a series of cultural and leisure activities.
 - Hungarian language (and culture) courses are offered for incoming students in the frame of Summer University programmes as well as regular courses during the semesters (http://www.elte.hu/en/language_courses)
- For the implementation of STA/STT-mobilities, a letter of invitation – issued by an ELTE contact person – is required.

2. The I UDINE01 will send a detailed Erasmus nomination list by e-mail. It cannot be guaranteed another modality to nominate Erasmus students from I UDINE01 (such as online nominations etc.).

3. Partner Universities have to send a detailed Erasmus nomination list by e-mail (to iss@uniud.it). It cannot be guaranteed the acceptance of another modality to nominate Erasmus students by partner Universities (such as online nominations etc.).

4. The I UDINE01 will send its decision (Information package) within 8 weeks at the maximum from the reception of the nomination letter.

5. Erasmus incoming student at the I UDINE01 has to collect the Transcript of Records before leaving Udine, otherwise the Transcript of Records will be issued and sent by the I UDINE01 no later than 5 weeks directly to the personal post address of the student.

6. Termination or modification of the agreement:

A unilateral decision to discontinue or to change the exchanges notified to the other party by September 20/./ will only take effect from the October of the following new academic year.

- Partner institution should send nominations to erasmus@elte.hu specifying the name, field of study, academic year and semester, number of months and e-mail address of the nominated student(s).

2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks.
3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 2 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
4. Termination or modification of the agreement

The inter-institutional agreement may be terminated by either party. The agreement will remain in effect until one party notifies the other of its wish to terminate. This should be done in writing, and a notice of at least one academic year should be given. In the event of such notice being given, all existing commitments to staff or students will be fulfilled. The agreement can be cancelled activities can be added to it, and changes in mobility data can be made annually provided they are communicated before January Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.


