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2. The receiving institution will send its decision within [5] weeks.

3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than [5] weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.

4. Termination of the agreement: The agreement will become operative on the date of signature of both universities and shall remain in force for a period of 5 years. In case of termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be sent to the partner university. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of conflict.
