- 2. Partner institution should send nominations by e-mail to international@arel.edu.tr
- 3. The receiving institution will send its decision within 2 weeks.
- 4. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- **I UDINE01** will send a detailed Erasmus nomination list <u>by e-mail</u>. It cannot be guaranteed another modality to nominate Erasmus students from I UDINE01.
- Partner Universities have to send a detailed Erasmus nomination list by e-mail (to <a href="iss@uniud.it">iss@uniud.it</a>). I UDINE01 cannot guarantee the acceptance of another modality to nominate Erasmus students by partner Universities (such as online nominations etc...).
- I UDINEO1 will send its decision (information package) within 8 weeks at the maximum from the reception of the nomination letter.
- Erasmus incoming student at **I UDINE01** has to collect the Transcript of Records before leaving Udine, otherwise the Transcript of Records will be issued and sent by I UDINE01 no later than 5 weeks directly to the personal post address of the student.

#### 5. Termination of the agreement

A notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 June 20XX will only take effect as of 1 June 20XX+1. Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict.

#### F. Information

#### 1. Grading systems of the institutions

Istanbul Arel University uses ECTS for transfer and accumulation. The university uses a letter grading system. Passing grades range from AA to DD for first-cycle (bachelor's) degrees while FF is a failing grade. For second-cycle (master's) degrees, passing grades range from AA to CC while DC, DD and FF are failing grades. For third-cycle (doctorate) degrees, passing grades range from AA to CB while CC, DC and FF are failing grades. One full academic year is 60 ECTS Credits and one semester is 30 ECTS Credits.
