- Partner Universities have to send a detailed Erasmus nomination list by e-mail (to <u>iss@uniud.it</u>). **I UDINE01** cannot guarantee the acceptance of another modality to nominate Erasmus students by partner Universities (such as online nominations etc...).
- **I UDINEO1** will send its decision (information package) within 8 weeks at the maximum from the reception of the nomination letter.
- Erasmus incoming student at **I UDINEO1** has to collect the Transcript of Records before leaving Udine, otherwise the Transcript of Records will be issued and sent by I UDINEO1 no later than 5 weeks directly to the personal post address of the student.
- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks.
- A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 5 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.
- Termination of the agreement: In the event of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given.
