

D. Additional requirements

- I UDINEO1 will send a detailed Erasmus nomination list by e-mail. It cannot be guaranteed another modality to nominate Erasmus students from I UDINEO1.
- Partner Universities have to send a detailed Erasmus nomination list by e-mail (to iss@uniud.it). I UDINEO1 cannot guarantee the acceptance of another modality to nominate Erasmus students by partner Universities (such as online nominations etc...).
- I UDINEO1 will send its decision (information package) within 8 weeks at the maximum from the reception of the nomination letter.
- Erasmus incoming student at **I UDINEO1** has to collect the Transcript of Records before leaving Udine, otherwise the Transcript of Records will be issued and sent by I UDINEO1 no later than 5 weeks directly to the personal post address of the student.
- 2. The receiving institution will send its decision within 4 weeks.
- 3. ETSEIB-UPC sends transcripts of records approximately within 4 weeks after the examinations period.
- 4. Termination of the agreement

If one or both parties wish to terminate the agreement a notice period of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 20XX will only take effect as of 1 September 20XX+1. The termination clauses must include the following disclaimer: "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."

In the event that notice of termination of the agreement is given, students who have already been selected and accepted for the exchange programme may still participate. Notwithstanding the termination of the agreement, each institution agrees that it will continue to fulfil its responsibilities to Exchange Students already registered at their institution until the completion of their particular exchange period.
