- 4. I UDINE01 will send its decision (information package) within 8 weeks at the maximum from the reception of the nomination letter.
- 5. Erasmus incoming student at the I UDINE01 has to collect the Transcript of Records before leaving Udine, otherwise the Transcript of Records will be issued and sent by I UDINE01 no later than 5 weeks directly to the personal post address of the student.
- 6. Termination or modification of the agreement:

A unilateral decision to discontinue or to change the exchanges notified to the other party by September 20/../ will only take effect from the October of the following new academic year.
