- 3. University of the Aegean will issue the Transcript of Records no later than 5 weeks after the exam period has finished. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than [xx] weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI. - 4. Termination of the agreement

This means that a unliteral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by J September 2DXX will only take effect as of J September 2DXX+1.
