IN PERSON AT UDINE (ITALY) FROM 25/07 TO 29/07

The COVID-19 pandemic led people to change their habits, their views of reality and their usual ways of staying in contact and in relationship to each other. These challenges have tremendously affected all citizens in all countries and, consequently, also greatly altered students' daily lives, individually, socially and educationally. In this context, the Blended Intensive Programme aims to promote (a) increasing students' preparedness to the current and the future pandemics; (b) promote effective coping strategies and the capacity to deal with the current and the future challenges; and at (c) deal with the stress perceived as a student, in a context not able to ensure positive, calm, and stable clinical environments due to the continuous changes required by the pandemic waves.
