You can also browse our integrated catalogue to access both print and electronic resources and PhD thesis, uniud.it/primo

You can log in as a registered user with your library credentials. This allows you to monitor your active loans and ILL-DD requests.

ELECTRONIC RESOURCES

The library subscribes to several bibliographic databases:

CabDirect, FSTA (Food Science and Technology Abstracts), MathSciNet, Journal Citation Reports, Web of Science, Scopus, the e-journals published by Elsevier (ScienceDirect) and Wiley, the e-journals from the IEEE, the American Chemical Society (ACS), the Association for Computing Machinery (ACM), the American Physical Society (APS), the Society for Industrial and Applied Mathematics (SIAM), the Institution of Civil Engineers (ICE) and the Management package from Emerald.

- connecting to the Eduroam Wi-Fi;

ABOUT THE LIBRARY

The Science and Technology Library hosts print and digital collections of over 300000 items (print books and print and electronic journals).

Our printed materials are on open shelves, arranged according to the DDC (Decimal Dewey Classification) system. Among the main disciplinary areas covered by our collection, there are: agriculture, architecture, botany, chemistry, city planning, economy, engineering, food science, geography, geology, IT and computer science, mathematics, physics, sociology, veterinary medicine, viticulture.

The Science and Technology Library has been endowed of two special collections:

- The *Library of the Società Alpina Friulana*: this collection is the historical part of the SAF library. It holds monographs, journals, geographical maps, atlases, ancient and modern studies in several languages on geography, history, geology, botany and physics.
- The *Athos Goidanich Library*: this collection holds general works on biology, zoology, entomology and several specialized sections of entomology for the following fields: agriculture, forestry, medicine and veterinary medicine.
- The library collection has moreover been enriched throughout the years by private donations.

OUR SERVICES

Library card registration

Monday – Thursday 9.00 – 13.00 / 15.00 – 17.00,
Friday 9.00 – 13.00

- Go to the Information Desk and fill the registration form with a valid I.D.
- The registration is free and granted to all students, professors and staff of the University of Udine, and to external users.
- Your European healthcare system ID will be validated as a library card - otherwise we will issue a new one.

Borrowing

- Students: 5 books for 1 month;
- Students working on graduation thesis: 8 books for 1 month;
- Professors: 20 books for 2 months;
- External users: 3 books for 1 month.

Text-books and reference books with a green dot on their spine are available only for a 1-day loan.

Your borrowing rights will be suspended for 3 days for a late return up to one week. If your loan is more than a week overdue, your borrowing rights will be suspended for 1 month.

Renewals

Loans can be renewed once (if there is no waiting list) by:

- Asking at the Loan Desk
- Calling us at 0432 558561 during opening hours
- Answering to our courtesy letter (one week before the due date) or sending us an email at scienze@uniud.it

Reservations

Books on loan can be reserved (at the loan desk or through your personal account on the catalogue website). Once the item is returned you will be notified by email. Books can be collected at the loan desk during the following 3 days. The uncollected books will be re-shelved.

Reading room

- Books from the Monographs room (first floor) are available for consultation;
- Paper journals are available for consultation in the side rooms (room A and B) of the main reading room. The latest issues are displayed in front of the loan desk;
- The Wi-Fi service for your laptop works with your ESSE3 credentials;
- Workstations with internet connection are available for bibliographic research. If you are an internal user, log in with your ESSE3 credentials. If you are an external user, please, ask for assistance at the Loan Desk.
- Lockers (1 euro operated) are available if you wish to deposit your belongings.

Intra-library loans with our off-campus locations

You can reserve a book from our off-campus locations in Pordenone and Gorizia at the loan desk, by sending us an email or in your personal area in the catalogue website. The book will be shipped to our library for you to collect.

You will receive an email alert when the book is available at the loan desk.

This service is free of charge. Please, collect the book as soon as you can.
